E-TENDER NOTICE

Sub: Engineering, Procurement and Construction Turnkey Services (Consultancy Services & Execution of Works) for LCA Engine Test Bed (ETB) and Module Change Workshop at IAF Jorhat or any other IAF Base anywhere in India

Online E-tenders are invited in Two-Bid System for works in E- mode and free view Tender documents are available on HAL Website www.hal-india.co.in under link Tenders, E-Procurement portal. It shall be available for download on the date as mentioned in the NIT or as amended and detailed therein the form of Corrigendum. Unless otherwise stipulated, downloaded Tender Document is free of cost.

Eligibility Criteria for Participation in this Tender: Subject to provisions in the Tender Document, participation in this tender process is open to all bidders / tenderers who fulfill Prequalification criteria as at para - A of this NIT.

Interested bidders / tenderers are requested to sign-in (new user sign – in only with DSC) online to obtain user-ID and password using Digital Signature. The tender documents comprises of Terms and conditions, Pre- qualification profiles and price bids. It is requested to download the Tender on acceptance of terms & conditions. The pre-qualification profile and price bids duly filled may be uploaded on E-Portal of HAL using Digital Signature before the last date & time for submission as mentioned in the tender notice.

This is an ELECTRONIC MODE of Tendering, any manual or mechanical errors committed before uploading or during the process of uploading the Document shall bound to be duly accepted by the Tenderer. The Tenderer shall not have claim whatsoever in this regard.

The experience and requisite documents should be in the name of bidder only and prior experience as any other business entity and / or requisite documents in the name of any other business entity shall not be considered.

A. Essential / Prequalification Criteria:

Agencies has to upload all supporting documents duly self attested with seal along with the Tender for the following criteria failing which offer is liable for rejection. The successful bidder (H1)has to submit the original documents for verification before award of contract.

- 1) The tenderer must be a Central Public Sector Enterprise:** Tenderer must be any Public Sector Undertaking set up by the Central Government to carry out civil or electrical works.
- 2) Annual Turnover:** Average annual turnover during the last 3 years, ending **March 31.03.2025** should be at least 30% of the estimated cost of the project. Profit & loss statement duly certified by chartered accountant with UDIN shall be considered for evaluation of turnover for the respective financial Year.
- 3) EMD:** Earnest Money Deposit as specified to be furnished in the form of Demand Draft / Bankers cheque / Pay Order drawn in favour of "Hindustan Aeronautics Limited [Bangalore]" payable at Bangalore, from a Nationalized Bank / Scheduled Bank, Deposit through any

other form will not be accepted. The scanned image of earnest money deposit to be uploaded online along with the tenders and original one to be submitted to the address mentioned below so as to reach Latest by 12.30 Hrs on the last date of submission. However the details of DD no date etc., to be provided in the prequalification profile.

The purchaser name in EMD DD should be in the name of Bidder / Tenderer only. EMD to reach the following address up to 12.30 Hrs on the last date of submission for tender document as mentioned in tender notice failing which tender will not be opened and any postal delay or any other reasons whatsoever will not be considered.

- 4) **Solvency:** The solvency required will be 40% of the estimated cost of the project. The solvency certificate shall be from a nationalized or scheduled bank and issued within a period of 12 Months from the final date of submission of the tender.
- 5) **Experience:** Experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 years ending on the previous day of submission of tender should be either of the following:
- a) **Three** similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to **40%** of estimated cost of the project mentioned in tender notice.
- Or**
- b) **Two** similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to **50%** of estimated cost of the project mentioned in tender notice.
- Or**
- c) **One** similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to **80%** of estimated cost of the project mentioned in tender notice.

Note:

- i. The work shall be completed as a whole. Partial value / completion are not to be considered.
- ii. In case of experience certificate obtained from organizations other than government, the same shall be supported with TDS certificate.
- iii. The meaning of "**Similar work**" for the purpose of tender is defined in Work details table. In case of composite work experience submitted by tenderer, the value of work pertains to similar nature of work will only be considered for evaluation. PMC should be undertaken for other companies.
- iv. Work experience completed under JV / as a sub-contract will not be considered for evaluation of experience criteria.

- 6) The Tenderers / Bidders have to comply with the provisions of ESI & PF act. Accordingly, The Tenderers / Bidders shall be required to Indemnify HAL for any liabilities arising on account of ESI & PF act as per the proforma at Tender Document before starting the work. A declaration to be submitted along with tender.
- 7) Registration certificate for GST no.
- 8) Intending agencies have to sign integrity pact with HAL along with online Tender which will be deemed as part of contract. Integrity pact shall cover all phases of contract i.e. from the stage of Notice Inviting Tender (NIT)/Tender till the conclusion of contract i.e. the final payment or completion of the duration of warranty/ guarantee period. Bids without a signed Integrity Pact shall be rejected.

IEM's will have access to all contract documents, whenever required. The agencies shall be required to furnish the information required for above purpose from time to time.

Note:

- a. All clarification/query/status w.r.t. tender and request for validity extension of the tender should be forwarded to contract section address mentioned at [A.3] and not to the IEM except query related to IP.
- b. The Original Integrity pact shall reach the HAL and not to IEM up to 12.30 Hrs. on the last date of submission for tender.

B. Documents to be uploaded along with Tender:

- (i) Certification of incorporation, Constitution and legal status along with attested copies of deeds / articles and memorandum of association, etc., as applicable.
- (ii) Power of attorney / authorization letter
- (iii) Copy of PAN card issued by income tax authority
- (iv) Income tax Returns for last three years.
- (v) Annual turnover for the last five years certified by CA with UDIN No.
- (vi) Balance sheet for the last five years certified by CA with UDIN No.
- (vii) Details of ECS viz., name of bank, MICR no., branch, account no. where payments are to be credited along with the scanned copy of blank cheque leaf.
- (viii) Environment, Social and Governance (ESG) or similar policies towards Environment, Sustainability, Social impact and Governance in Company's business practice, as applicable.

C. General Instructions for submission of tenders:

1. Any clarification in the tender document shall be addressed in writing to the address given at [A.3] on or before bid clarification date and time as mentioned at tender notification in HAL e-portal
2. Incomplete / invalid tenders are liable for rejection and no correspondence will be entertained in case of rejection.
3. Non-uploading of requisite documents due to negligence or ignorance by the tenderers leading to disqualification will have to be borne by the tenderer only. There shall be no claim whatsoever in this regard.
4. Tenderer / Bidders must read the complete 'Tender Document'.

NIT is an integral part of the Tender Document and serves a limited purpose of invitation and gives salient summary of the tender information. It does not purport to contain all relevant details for submission of bids. Hence, Bidders must go through the complete Tender Document for details before submission of their Bids.

5. Tenderers / Bidders are subject to be disqualified, even though they meet the Pre-qualifying criteria, if they make misleading or false representations in the request, statements and attachments submitted in proof of qualification requirements including holding information and / or have record of poor performance such as abandoning the works, not properly completing the contract, inordinate delays in completion, litigation history, or financial failures, requesting for claims not admissible under the contract conditions, etc.
6. Tender Documents duly filled & uploaded within the last date of submission as mentioned in the tender notice. The last date for receipt of Tender will not be extended under any circumstances, unless otherwise the date is declared a holiday for HAL, in which case the next working day will be treated as the last date of receipt of Tender document.
7. This advertisement can also be seen in HAL Website www.hal-india.co.in, under Tenders, Facilities Management Division, Tenders and this tender notice forms part of the tender document.

D. Clarification on Technical Bid Evaluation:

1. During evaluation and comparison of bids, HAL may, at their discretion, ask the bidder for clarifications on the bid. The request for clarification shall be given in writing by registered / speed post / email, asking the tenderer to respond by a specified date, and also mentioning therein that, if the tenderer does not comply or respond by the date, his tender will be liable to be rejected. Depending on the outcome, such tenders are to be ignored or considered further. No change in prices or substance of the bid including specifications, shall be sought, offered or permitted. No post-bid clarification at the initiative of the bidder shall be entertained. The shortfall information / documents will be sought only in case of historical documents (Which were to be submitted at the time of the tender opening). These documents will be called only on basis of the recommendations of HAL committee / TEC. (Example: In case the tenderer provided the details of Solvency certificate in the PQ form / Check List and not uploaded the supporting document in proof of qualification, such documents will be called for with a target date and on receipt of the said shortfall documents, it can be examined and accepted only when the date of issue of documents is as indicated in the NIT against each qualifying parameter). So far as the submission of documents is concerned with regard to qualification criteria, after submission of the tender, only related shortfall documents will be asked for and

considered. For example, if the bidder has submitted a contract without its completion / performance certificate, the certificate can be asked for and considered. However, no new contract should be asked for so as to qualify the bidder.

2. HAL also reserves right to seek confirmation/clarification from the issuer agency, on the supporting documents submitted by the bidder.

E. Evaluation of Bids:

1. Bidders who qualifies essential criteria as per Para A only will be considered for further evaluation as per Annexure-1 of tender document which consists of Core Parameters [A], Technical Parameters [B] and Presentation [C].
2. The bidders who get minimum marks in Core Parameters [A] will be considered for further evaluation of Technical Parameters [B] and who achieves a minimum of 30 marks in A & B parameters [Total of A + B i.e. 30/75] will qualify for Presentation [C].
3. The bidders qualified in A & B shall be invited for presentation before high level HAL committee.
4. In presentation, bidders shall get minimum 10 marks out of 25 marks. The HAL technical evaluation committee will select the bidders who got a minimum of 40 marks out of the 100 marks in evaluation of Technical Bid and Presentation.
5. The commercial bid of bidders who are qualifying [Minimum of 40/100] in the combined total, will only be opened. All presentation material shall be the property of the HAL. No presentation material to be attached with the technical / price bids.
6. The committee decision shall be final and binding on all the bidders. The unsuccessful bidders shall have no claim whatsoever in this regard.
7. Technical evaluation marks [A + B + C] obtained by the bidder shall be evaluated with the allotted weightage of 60%.
8. Price quoted by the bidders shall be evaluated with the allotted weightage of 40%.
9. The bid obtaining the highest total [H1] combined score [Based on technical evaluation and price bid] will be the successful bidder. However, HAL may call for negotiations if required and may recommend for award of contract / cancellation depending on the reasonability of offer.

F. Pre-bid Meeting:

The pre-bid meeting is proposed to be held on **04.06.2026 @ 2.00 P.M.** in Conference Hall, FMD, Near HAL Sports Club, Bangalore to facilitate any clarifications required for the tenderers. However, clarification required to be submitted to HAL on or before **03.06.2026**. It is not mandatory to attend the pre-bid meeting.

Note:

1. Corrigendum / addendum / amendments / clarification, etc., with respect to works, if any, shall be hosted in HAL e-portal. Interested bidders / agencies are advised to visit HAL e-portal regularly as no separate information / advertisement shall be published in the news paper in this regard including any postponement of tender opening date.
2. Interested agencies are required to follow the instructions provided in this tender notice "Procedure to download & submission of tender" to view, download, register on HAL e-portal including participation in tendering.

23. When the user finishes with the filling and uploading of scanned BG/DD, the "Red Color" will automatically turn to "Black Color" which reflects that the user is two steps ahead for the submission.
24. Click "Click here to Download Empty Document" to download the Technical/Price Sheet and fill the same without changing the "File Name" and save on to the computer.
25. Click "Click here to Upload the Filled File", select the filled file which was already filled and saved in the same name. Click "Ok" to upload the filled Technical/Price Sheet to the tender.
26. Note that when the user uploads the filled Technical/Price Sheet, the "Red Color" will automatically turn to "Black Color" which reflects that user is ready for the final submission.
27. Provide all the mandatory documents requested by the official.
28. For uploading Support document first vendor has to upload all documents in "Document Library" and to attach the documents to tender click on particular tender edit attachment and click on "Click here to attach general documents" and select the file and attach.
29. Prior to submission, verify whether all the required documents have been attached and uploaded to the particular tender or not because once submitted bids cannot be taken back.
